New hangars are progressively being clad before the new perimeter fence is erected around the edge near the Westpac Helicopter site.

Our newly formed and grassed Taxiway D has been opened in November so please refer to your landing chart for Whitianga to enable pilots to be familiar with the layout and usage of this taxiway to enable the runway grass to last through our summer months.

When parking vehicles beside hangars, please park parallel to the doors, against the doors. This provides clearance for aircraft taxiing past on the main taxiway. Vehicles parked facing or reversed to the doors have been blocking the main taxiway causing considerable inconvenience.

Whananaki Airstrip: Private airstrip 68 miles north of West Auckland at S35° 30.5' E174° 27.8". To find it fly into the Whananaki estuary entrance at low altitude and turn left at the shore, and you'll be on short final for runway 20 for the airfield which runs between the road and the harbour shore. Unconfirmed Google Earth measurements show it as 500m long aligned 02/20 at 6°. Contact Martin Farrand Ph 021 933 804


Marlborough Aero Club 15th Feb 2025


